WHAT IS "GETTA" ABOUT?

The project aims to bring together 30 young people from 5 different countries to raise young people's awareness and address the stereotypes and discrimination based on gender, which is made by people in the community towards other people or groups.

The purpose of theatre and art methods, as an important tool of free expression and creativity, is to prove that all people have the right to act and express as they want, without disturbing or offending anyone else. During the project's activities, participants will get to learn the roots of gender-based violence, starting from ancient Greece until today.







MAIN OBJECTIVES

- Raise awareness about gender-based violence as an important socially relevant topic since ancient times and stimulate engagement in society and active participation;
- Use theatre and art methods as an effective way of promoting human rights and active participation;
- Promote intersectional dialogue by including young people with different genders, experiences and backgrounds;
- Facilitate the understanding of the society by assisting civil society cooperation and young people's active participation in solving societal issues, such as gender-based violence.

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

- Each national team will consist of 4 young people (18-30 years old) and 1 group leader (18+ with no age limit).
- There is no need to have any background experience in theatre or gender issues. All people are welcome to apply.
- Participants with fewer opportunities are highly encouraged to apply.



ACTIVITIES

The youth exchange activities will be based on theatre and art forms. All sessions will be delivered by experts on theatre and adult education trainers, using inclusive activities and language, all based on non-formal education.







TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Participants are highly encouraged to use sustainable travelling methods to reach Greece (bus, train, carpooling).

Travel costs will be reimbursed until the budget limit, set by the Erasmus+ Programme, **based on the real costs** of the tickets.

Reimbursement will be done by bank transfer only after all participants send their original boarding passes, receipts, invoices and tickets to the organisers by post and via e-mail (original & scanned versions) to giannistsotso@gmail.com.

The best option is to arrive in Athens, either by flight, ferry, train, bus, carpooling, and for the transportation to Poros, more information will be given to the selected participants.

WELCOME TO POROS ISLAND



The island of Poros is located on the southeastern edge of the Saronic Gulf near the Peloponnese, it covers an area of 23 sq. km. and consists of two smaller islands, Sferia (capital - port) and Kalavria, which are connected by a small canal.



Poros is distinguished by its idyllic beaches and by its dense piny vegetation. The traditional settlement of built Poros. amphitheatrically on the hill of Sferia, with its historic Tower Clock cobbled and neoclassical streets mansions along the coastal offers road. beautiful а picture of traditional Greek architecture, while the lively waterfront is ideal afternoon walks.
